Tech Prep

Tech Prep is a program of study which begins in high school, continues at a postsecondary institution, culminates in an Associate in Applied Science degree, two-year certificate, or two-year apprenticeship, and leads to related meaningful employment. In the Moraine Valley region, the college and the Moraine Area Career System (MACS) have established articulation agreements that grant college credit for proficiency in Tech Prep courses taken in high school. To be eligible, a student must:

1. Attend a school within in the Moraine Area Career System (MACS). The MACS high schools include all of the schools in the following districts: 217, 218, 220, 229, 230 & 231.
2. Complete designated high school Tech Prep course with a grade of "B" or better.
3. Submit a completed college application and high school transcript confirming graduation to Moraine Valley's admissions office.
4. Submit a transcript confirming high school graduation to the MACS office.
5. Enroll at the college (either full or part time) as a certificate or degree-seeking student within two years of graduating from high school.

After graduation, the high schools will submit names or forms of all graduating students with eligible Tech Prep credits to the MACS office regardless if they are enrolled or plan to enroll at Moraine Valley. The MACS office will process and record each student and then forward that information to the registration office where credit will be posted on a student's transcript once they register and enroll at the college.

The following table depicts the match-up between those high school courses currently articulated to Moraine Valley courses, including the available credit hours and the approved programs associated with articulated courses.

PLEASE NOTE: The articulation process is on-going with review and revision of course curriculum occurring regularly. As such, articulation requirements/agreements and course titles may change without notice. The most up-to-date and accurate articulation information will be available at each of the participating high schools as well as through the MACS office. Please contact the MACS office for more information.
