Student Right-to-Know Information on Graduation and Transfer-out Rates

The following information is provided in compliance with federal regulations. The rates below reflect the graduation and transfer-out status of students who enrolled in 2003 and were tracked for three years.

During the fall semester of 2003, 1,588 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students entered Moraine Valley Community College. After three years (as of August 31, 2006):

- 19.1% had graduated from Moraine Valley
- 33.6% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 23.6% were still enrolled at Moraine Valley

While reviewing this information, please be aware that graduation rates are affected by a number of factors. Some students leave because of academic deficiencies. Some students begin full time but are unable to continue attending full time and thus would need more than three years to graduate.
