

Suggested Mentoring Activities To help provide a support network for a new employee, the mentor may want to engage in some of the following activities:

- Meet for breakfast or lunch
- Tour the campus
- Visit various departments on campus
- Attend a college meeting, such as PAC or other department sponsored meetings/activities
- Introduce employee to other faculty and staff
- Explain some college procedures
- Discuss emergency preparedness procedures
- Discuss various employee events and accompany the new staff member to them
- Review the college's mission, vision, values, and strategic priorities
- Review benefits and staff orientation
- Discuss the mentoring program and what the responsibilities and expectations are
- Discuss each other's background and professional development/career goals
- Attend a FPAC event/activity
- Participate together in a wellness event/activity
- Attend student events/activities ('the fun stuff')
- Attend athletic events
- If mentee shows interest in an area that the college has a committee for, connect them with the employees on that committee
- Attend sponsored college/employee events (ex. retiree reception)
- Show mentee how to use Training Manager to register for CTL workshops
- Tour of the cafeteria
- Ride along with the MV Police Department
- Encourage the mentee to take a course or take one with them
