APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION – RESIDENCY

Residency and Admission

Moraine Valley Community College's Nursing Program has a selective and competitive admission process. In compliance with the Illinois Public Community College Act, if space is not available for all students applying to the Nursing Program, priority admission is given to applicants residing in the MVCC district. Out-of-district applicants will be considered for admission after all qualified and eligible in-district applicants have been offered admission.

Proof of Residency

The mailing address provided on the program application will be used for residency purposes. Documents to prove in-district residency must be submitted with the application. The types of documents which may serve as acceptable proof of residency are provided in the college's residency policy. Information about Moraine Valley's district and its residency policy are available in the catalog.

Special Residency Classifications

Students who live out-of-district but qualify for the in-district tuition rate per the college's residency policy do not necessarily qualify as in-district residents for Nursing Program admission purposes. Refer to below:

In-District Employment - Students which qualify for the in-district tuition rate based on full-time employment within the MVCC district are not considered in-district residents for Nursing Program admission purposes.

Property Owner - Students who qualify for the in-district tuition rate based on the ownership of property within the MVCC district, but do not reside at that property, are not considered in-district residents for Nursing Program admission purposes.

Chargeback/Cooperative Agreement - Students residing in another community college district which has an agreement with Moraine Valley are not considered in-district residents for Nursing Program admission purposes. However, preference will be given to students residing in districts with these agreements before other out-of-district students.
