Summary	MVCC students who complete the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing at MVCC and maintain a 2.5 GPA will be guaranteed admission to the IUN RN-BSN program. Up to 84 credit hours of General Education and Nursing courses can be counted toward the BS in Nursing at IUN. MVCC students must provide evidence of passing the NCLEX exam prior to enrolling in any courses at IUN.
Number of Credit Hours Accepted	84 maximum
Scholarships and/or Financial Benefits	Students may be eligible for the Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP) tuition discount program. Out of state tuition is reduced to 150% of the in state tuition rate.
Admissions Information	Students are encouraged to apply to IUN in their first semester of the AAS in Nursing program at MVCC to access IUN academic advising.
Other Information	Students completing the AAS in Nursing and attaining a 2.5+ cumulative GPA are guaranteed admission to the IUN RN-BSN program.
