MVCC students must complete all courses with a “C” or better, and credits from the following departments do not qualify: Health, Nutrition, and Physical Education. No more than 30 hours for studio credit will be awarded for transfer credit. A basic outline of degree requirements is below; however, MVCC students should follow only the exact advising recommendations from SAIC.
