**TUESDAY, APRIL 12** Students who completed *20-51 credit hours* can register.

**WEDNESDAY, APRIL 13** Students who completed *0.5-19 credit hours* can register.

**THURSDAY, APRIL 14** Students who are currently enrolled in 12 or more hours (full time) can register, and students who are currently enrolled part time can register.

**MONDAY, APRIL 18** Open registration for new students.

If you plan to enroll in course(s) that will transfer to a four year university, and those courses are NOT part of the degree/certificate you are pursuing, Department of Education will not pay for those course(s). You will be responsible for the tuition of those course(s).

Financial aid includes PELL Grant, SEOG Grant, MAP Grant and Direct Loans.

## Students receiving Veteran Benefits:

If you are receiving GI Bill benefits, only courses that satisfy requirements outlined by the curriculum guide or graduation evaluation form can be certified for Veteran Affairs purposes.

GI Bill includes Post 9/11, Montgomery Ch. 30, 31, 1606 & 1607.
