Run or walk the Halloween 5K, Enjoy fun family activities

Grab some gym shoes and a costume for the 11th annual Halloween 5K run/walk and Kid's Dash on Saturday, Oct. 26, 9 a.m., at Moraine Valley Community College, 9000 W.

College Parkway, Palos Hills.

Participants can walk or run the officially timed 5K (3.1 mile) path throughout campus. The Kid's Dash will start at 10:15 a.m. for children 3 to 12 years old. All pre-registered participants will receive a T-shirt. Costumes are encouraged for the individual and group costume contest.

Runners/walkers can sign their children up for the Little Pumpkins Patch, a free activity area open during and after the race that includes pumpkin decorating and various Halloween activities.

Registration is \$40 for community members/alumni and \$30 for Moraine Valley students/employees. Prices go up by \$5 on Oct. 1. The Kid's Dash is \$15 until race day. Anyone who wants to register their child for the Little Pumpkins Patch must be signed up for the race.

Moraine Valley Alumnus Mark Sebby scholarship announced at NDT lab ribbon cutting

Moraine Valley Community College used a \$500,000 grant from the Congressional Funded Community Project to upgrade its Nondestructive Testing (NDT) laboratory. The college unveiled the

space during a ribbon-cutting ceremony in August.

The facility now features cutting-edge technology, including a magnetic particle inspection machine, phased arrays ultrasonic testing devices, eddy current scanners and probes, and digital radiography tools. A new liquid penetrant station is coming soon.

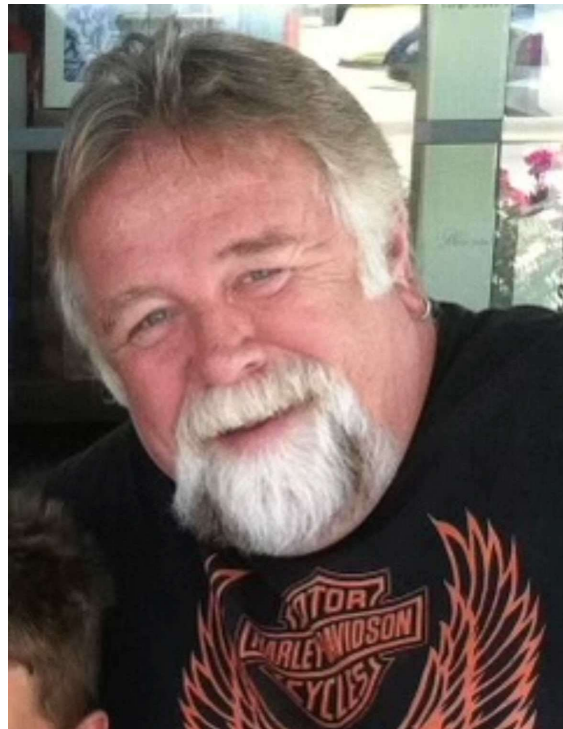
NDT is a growing field that plays a critical role in assuring that structural components and systems perform their function in a reliable and cost-effective fashion. NDT technicians and engineers define and implement tests that locate and characterize material conditions and flaws that might otherwise cause less visible but troubling events.

"Receiving my award, the Jesus DeAnda Memorial Scholarship, from the DeAnda family, helps me financially of course, but, more importantly, it helps me emotionally to know that someone out there, who I do not even know, believes in me," said scholarship recipient, Nicholas Barragen.
