STUDENT SUCCESS CENTER

Moraine Valley Community College opened the doors to a Student Success Center in August 2016. The renovated building is home to the Academic Skills Center, Honors Program, Student Success Department, Testing Center, Veterans Resource Center, and offices for counseling and academic advising. It also houses spacious classrooms for student orientation sessions, a computer lab and student lounge. The Moraine Valley Foundation pledged \$450,000 over three years for the furniture within the center.

Since the building opened, the programs within have experienced a huge boost in student participation. The Honors Program has the largest enrollment to date with more than 300 participants. The new Testing Center offers students a more spacious and professional environment with an increase of more than 100 testing stations for computer and paper-based testing, a 30-seat testing lab for specialized and professional testing and a 74-seat lab for placement testing.

The new Academic Skills Center provides learning zones, glassed-in study rooms equipped with state-of-the-art media technology and large glass boards where students process complex problems in math and science. The Foundation is proud to support the dramatic transformation of this space to enhance student success.



SHAKESPEARE’S LEGACY LIVES ON

In honor of William Shakespeare’s 400th birthday, Moraine Valley honored his legacy by transforming an open area on campus into a blooming garden dedicated to the Bard.

Just north of the Fine and Performing Arts Center and surrounded by trees is a brick-lined pathway typical of an English garden. It wanders through foliage referenced in Shakespeare’s poems and plays, and is marked with signage quoting those works.

The Foundation offers the opportunity for individuals to leave their legacy by purchasing a brick in the garden. This is an ideal way to honor a Moraine Valley graduate, loved one or someone who has made a difference in your life. The money raised through this campaign is used to support college programs and student scholarships.

GET BACK INTO THE CLASSROOM**

Career choice would have made her mom proud

Breathing this past year wasn't easy for Lisa Washington. It wasn't because of a medical condition, though. It was because of the stress over how she was going to pay for her classes.

"Ever since I got accepted into the nursing program, I couldn't relax yet because I still had to try to figure out how I was going to pay for it," Washington said. "Winning the scholarship gave me time to finally breathe—and enjoy the fact that I was accepted into the program."

Being the recipient of the Returning Women Diversity Scholarship meant Washington could breathe a little easier, and she could worry less about money. "It was really hard to balance my bills at home as well as the tuition payments," she said. "You don't want to get dropped from your classes if you don't pay, and if you're late, you'll have some extra fees. It was hard to have a job that was flexible enough to allow me to come to school and have time to study and still be able to pay for the courses."

Deciding it was time for a new career, Washington did her homework and determined Moraine Valley was her best choice to start on the path to becoming a nurse. There were several influencing factors—the reputation as a great program, talking to a few people who had successfully gone through the program and meeting some truly compassionate nurses who cared for her mother suffering from a serious illness.

"My mom was at Rush Medical Center. I was there every single day, and I got to see how the nurses and doctors worked so well together. And the ones who were really compassionate just stuck with me," Washington said. "That's what my mom needed—nurses who listened to her and were not being technical to get information or give orders from the doctor. It really changed her moods and lifted her spirits—they remembered she was a person. Meeting those nurses and seeing how they really affect people, well, that was it. I knew for sure I wanted to be a nurse."

Her mother has since died, but Washington knows in her heart that her mom would be thrilled with her career choice. "I think my mom would be really happy I am going to be a nurse. I believe she would think I will make a great nurse. And I know she would be happy I am getting some help with paying for school," she said.

Washington realizes the obstacles that once were in her way are now passable thanks to the scholarship. "If someone can give money for a scholarship, I would say to give with all your heart. It really closes the gap between a person wanting to reach their life goals and actually achieving them," she said. "Every little bit helps and makes such a difference from the beginning to continuing and then walking across the stage at graduation."

DANIEL GEITER, 2009

Dr. Daniel Geiter has been working to create a college that would help ex-offenders get an education to help reduce their chances of being re-incarcerated. He was chief executive officer at Catalyst Educational Research Center in Chicago. Geiter earned an Associate in Arts degree from Moraine Valley in 2009. He also earned a bachelor's degree from Saint Xavier University, a master's degree from the University of Chicago, and a doctorate degree from Benedictine University.



KEITH KARLSON, 1997

Attorney Keith Karlson specializes in public safety labor law, constitutional rights of public employees and public section pension law representing police and fire unions in Illinois and Indiana. Karlson earned an Associate in Arts degree from Moraine Valley in 1997, a bachelor's degree from Eastern Illinois University, a master's degree from Ball State University, and a juris doctorate from DePaul University College of Law.



KATHLEEN KARWOSKI, 1986

Kathleen Karwoski has been a registered dental hygienist for more than 30 years. She created the Dental Personnel Placement Service, a temporary and permanent placement service for auxiliary dental staffing; and has coordinated dental seminars for more than 200 professionals bi-annually. INSPIRING FACULTY INNOVATION AND STEM EDUCATION

Stem Expo

More than 600 seventh graders in May explored science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) through hands-on learning at the inaugural Moraine Valley Community College STEM Expo funded through a Faculty Innovation Grant from the Moraine Valley Foundation.

The STEM Expo featured 32 educational sessions ranging from cybersecurity, drone flying and marine biology to LEGO stop-motion moviemaking, creating memes, biological explorations, and Minecraft HTML. The free event was hosted on the Moraine Valley campus in collaboration with the Foundation and community partners such as Argonne National Laboratory, Fermilab, the Children's Museum in Oak Lawn, the Flying M Academy, and students from Reavis High School and Community High School District 218.

Moraine Valley Employee Giving Surpasses National Benchmarks

EMPLOYEE GIVING CAMPAIGN

Contributions from Moraine Valley employees are more than double the average participation rates at other educational institutions.

According to the Council for Advancement and Support of Education, the average participation rate of faculty and staff to their college foundation is 28 percent. Over this past year, 499 full-time faculty and staff members contributed with an overall participation rate of 75 percent.

In total, more than \$50,000 was raised in FY2016 to provide additional financial assistance and scholarships for students. The Moraine Valley Foundation has hosted its Employee Giving Campaign for five consecutive years with faculty and staff donating more than \$250,000 in support of the Foundation.

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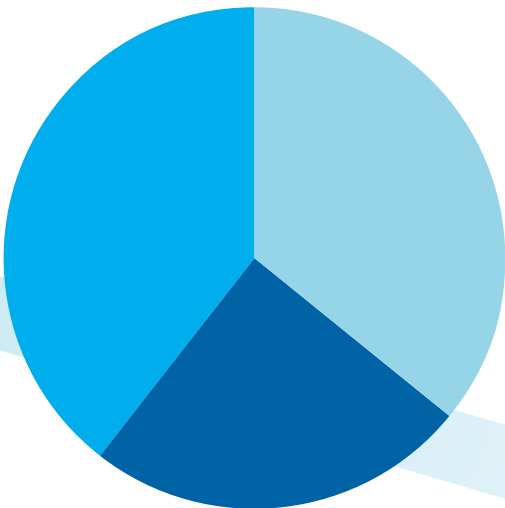
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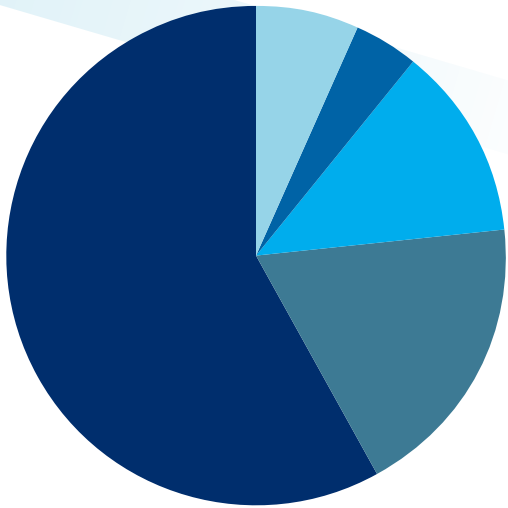
