Why would a man and woman from a far northwest suburb give scholarships to a community college in a southwest suburb?

Because of Riley Spreadbury, a 2016 graduate of Moraine Valley.

Bruce and Deborah Pfaff created the Riley Spreadbury Scholarship, awarded annually to two or more recipients who have overcome or are overcoming adversity, and meet financial and GPA requirements.

“We give these scholarships to honor Riley’s great accomplishments in overcoming many obstacles,” Bruce said. “We want to give hope to others who are trying to overcome obstacles and to let qualified students achieve without undue financial worries.”

The Pfaffs learned about Moraine Valley when Bruce was the trial lawyer who handled the proceedings when Riley became paralyzed as a result of a spinal injury after a medical procedure. “It makes my wife and me very happy to be able to do this for Moraine Valley students in honor of Riley,” Bruce said. “She is an inspiration to many people – Deborah and I included. She never quit trying to achieve despite a horrible event when she was 12. It does not define her life; it motivates her life’s work.”

After receiving her Associate in Applied Science degree in recreational therapy, Riley earned a bachelor’s degree in the same field from Illinois State University. She is devoting her career to helping others live better lives.

“I’m incredibly honored,” Riley said. “Bruce knows how much I love Moraine Valley. This school does so much for its students. It facilitates an environment where you could really explore what you’re interested in. For Bruce and his wife to attach my name to these generous scholarships is just such a true honor.”

Luanne Spiros has never forgotten the generosity that allowed her to continue her classes at Moraine Valley. “I was fortunate to be a recipient of a Moraine Valley scholarship. Without that, it was unlikely I was going to be able to pursue school in any fashion. Fast forward 30 years, and I now also have a bachelor’s degree, a master’s degree and 20-plus certifications.”

Spiros, and her husband, Joe Weber, had two reasons in mind when they created the Arlene Spiros Academic Scholarship. “One was to pay it forward to support single mothers,” she said. “For us, there’s a significance to the belief that each of us has an obligation to leave the world better than when we arrived. So we focused on how we might give back.”

The second reason was to honor Luanne’s mother, Arlene. “Women who are seeking to be great mothers, great citizens, great students — it’s what inspires us. We’ve decided that providing just some external support may be all that’s needed to move forward,” Spiros said.

Their support is helping Jana’ Sullivan move forward. “Receiving support to continue my education means the entire world to me,” Sullivan said. “Words could never fully explain how much I appreciate a total stranger believing in my future goals and accomplishments. The Spiros have given me the chance to not only reach for the stars, but to catch one — and shake hands with the moon.”



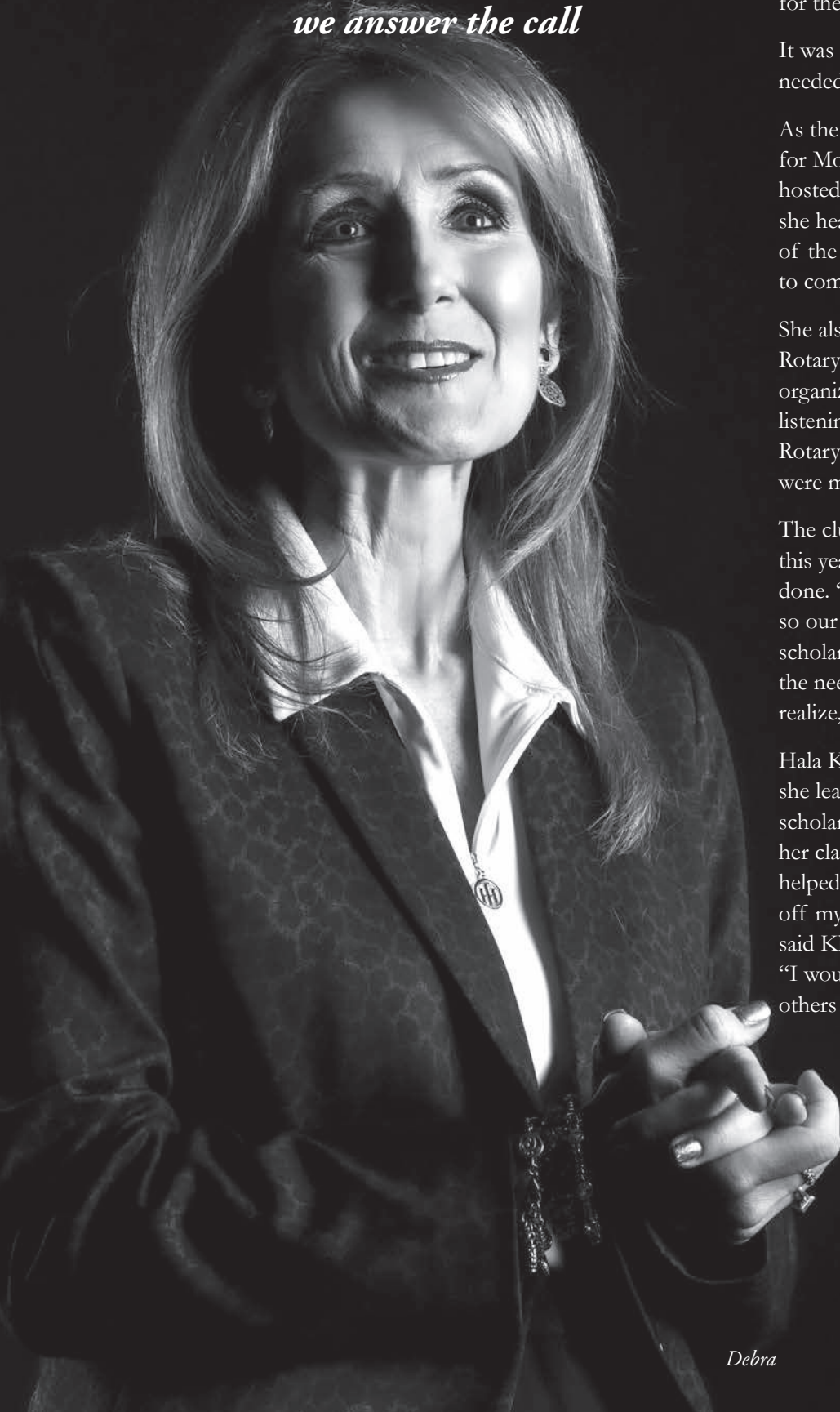

Debra Baker listened to a group of women share their stories about the challenges they faced as they attempted to make a better life for themselves and their families.

It was at that moment Baker decided she needed to do something to help.

As the vice president of wealth management for Morgan Stanley in Orland Park, Baker hosted a table at an event on campus where she heard female students not only talk of the hardships, but of their determination, to complete college.

She also was president of the Orland Park Rotary Club, an active community service organization in the Orland/Palos area. "Just listening to the stories of these women, I knew Rotary had to do something. These women were my 'why,'" Baker said.

The club provided two \$1,000 scholarships this year, and Baker is hopeful more can be done. "One of our big platforms is education so our club is very passionate about giving scholarships to local students. We see where the need is. It's so much greater than people realize," she said.

Hala Khalil felt a sense of relief when she learned she was awarded the Rotary scholarship because she was unable to pay for her classes. "I was so grateful. This scholarship helped me tremendously and relieved a weight off my shoulders from my financial struggles," said Khalil, who plans to go to medical school. "I would love to become a doctor and help others by giving back to the community."

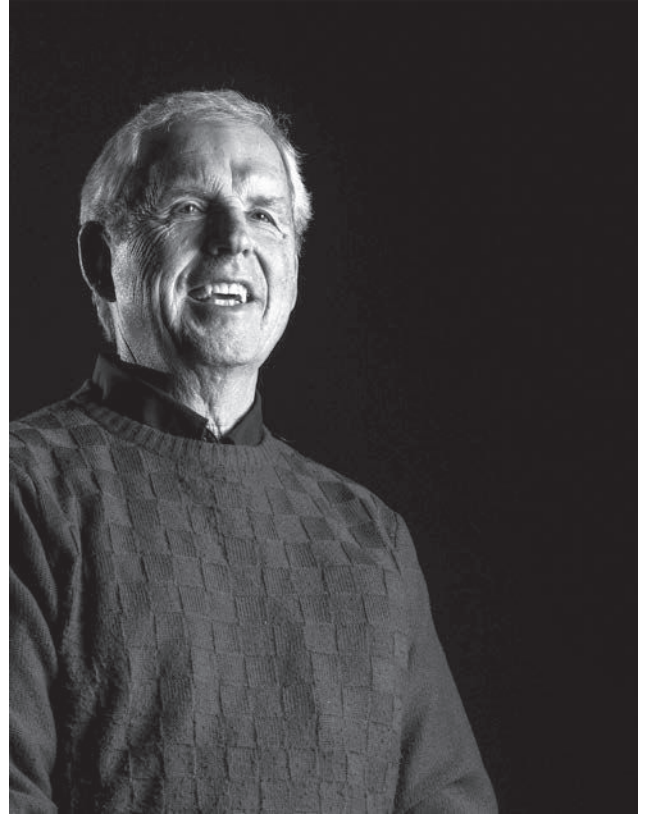

Generous, big-hearted, empathetic and caring all describe giving. Those words also describe Moraine Valley employees — especially in the fall during the Foundation's Employee Giving Campaign.

"Our impressive giving rate of more than 74% is an indication of our employees' kindness," said Patti Friend, director of Alumni and Annual Programs. "When our employees hear of the struggles and challenges many of our students face, I see the compassion, and even some tears, in their eyes. It makes me realize their caring is heartfelt and goes much deeper than their pockets."

More than \$84,000 was raised from nearly 600 employees, which was a 44% increase over the previous year's employee giving campaign. Additional funds were dispersed to the United Way of Metro Chicago and Community Health Charities.

The reasons vary why people give, but almost all agree it is to help others, particularly our students, and a way to give back. Working closely with students, Dr. Jo Ann Jenkins, dean of Student Success and Title IX coordinator, has seen firsthand some of the struggles students face. "It takes a lot for many students to come in search of bettering their lives and the lives of their families. Anything I can do to help students achieve their educational goals and possibly impact generational change by my donation, I see as a privilege," she said.

Dr. Tom Dow, Communications/Literature/Language department chair, gives because he understands the need. "I am very blessed to have a job I love. I give to the Foundation because I know my donation is going to student scholarships. I'm supporting my students because I know they need it," he said.

Catherine Dixon, secretary II in Academic Services, is a longtime supporter of the Foundation.

"I give to Employee Giving because it's a way I can directly help the students. I'd like to think I'm helping build up the scholarship funds for students who otherwise struggle so they have another opportunity," she said.

the Foundation supports education through scholarships

Many students face challenges that easily could derail their education plans. With most of our students working full- or part-time jobs while going to school, raising families and juggling funds to pay for rent, groceries and car payments, finances are their biggest obstacle.

Realizing this need, the Moraine Valley Foundation is relentless in its pursuit of raising funds to help our students overcome obstacles. Thanks to our generous donors, this year we awarded more than 150 scholarships. These awards ranged from \$500 to \$2,500 per semester. Scholarships are based on outstanding academic achievement, community service and/or financial need. More than 1,400 students applied and qualified for scholarships this year, an increase from the previous year, indicating the need for financial support is growing.

Thank you to our generous donors who established scholarships in honor of a loved one, friend or coworker, or left a legacy through a planned gift. Civic organizations and businesses realizing the value of education in their communities create many of our scholarships. Other scholarships are developed by Moraine Valley faculty, staff, alumni and retirees, demonstrating their continued support of our students.

Two of the new scholarships offered to Moraine Valley students this year honor loved ones of the donors.

The Beverly Keehn scholarship was created by her daughter, Holly Bartecki, a Moraine Valley graduate, and Bartecki's fiancé, Steve Pappageorge, executive director of Corporate, Community and Continuing Education at Moraine Valley. "We wanted to do something that captured what we loved so much about her and who she was as a person," Bartecki said, noting Keehn was a single mom who took classes at Moraine Valley to advance her career. "We are thrilled to honor her memory."

Moraine Valley graduate Debbie Izzo started a scholarship this year in honor of the people who supported her pursuit of an education. The Lor-Izzo scholarship is named for Izzo's mother, Lore; her aunt, Lorraine; and her husband, Gil. "All three were very instrumental in making sure I had what I needed to get through the Nursing Program, whether it was time, money, childcare, extra motivation, encouragement — whatever I needed," Izzo said.

Debbie received a scholarship to help her, and creating this scholarship is her way of paying it forward. "It's important for me to give back to the place that set the foundation for me. I'm at a time in my life that I have the capacity to do this, and I think the people for whom this scholarship was named would have approved."

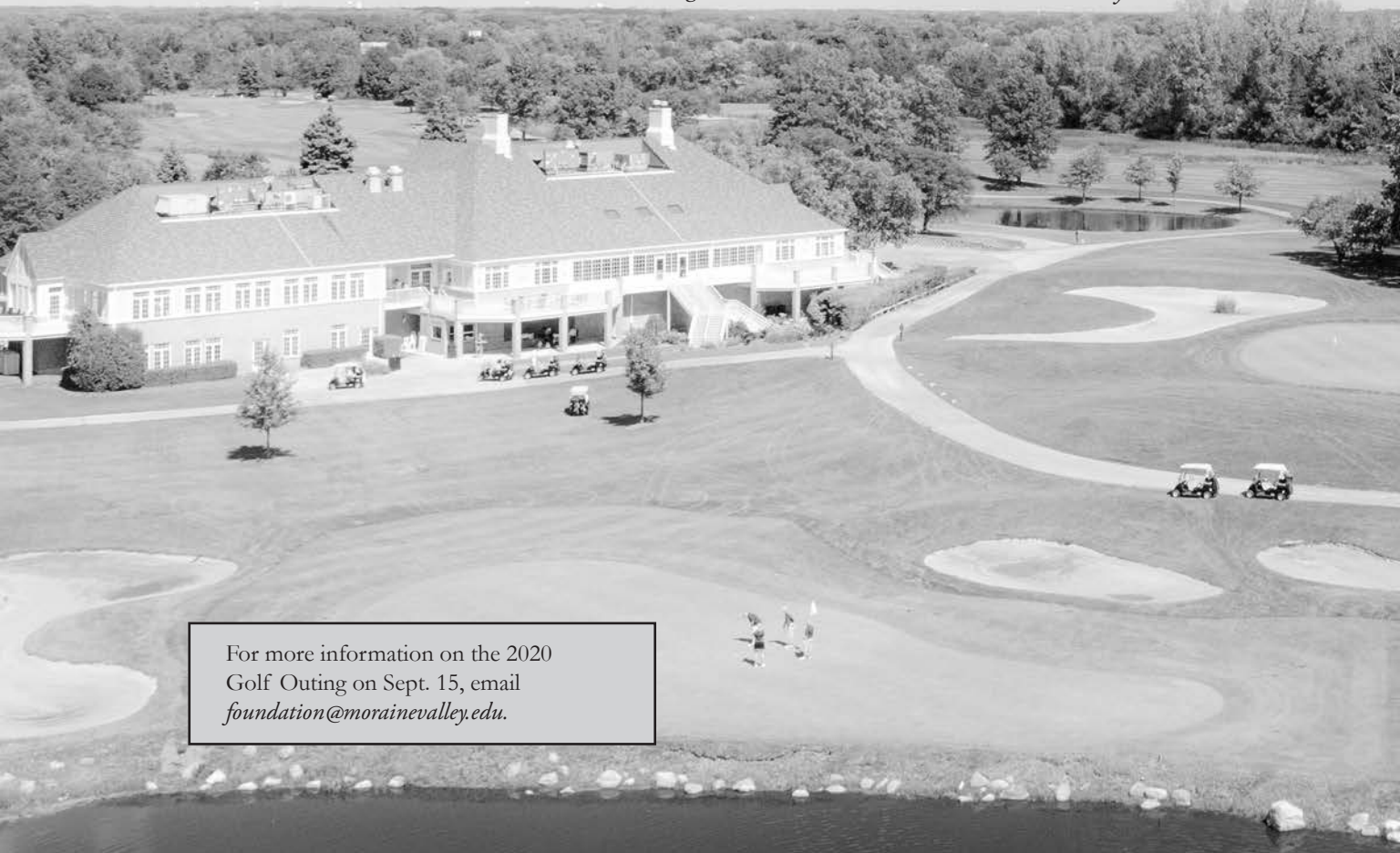

The 2019 Hall of Fame inductees are Holly Bartecki, Dylan Lloyd, José Ángel Navejas and Dave Shalabi.

Bartecki is a graduate who gave so much of her time and talent to Moraine Valley while she was a student. She's been a loyal supporter of Moraine Valley and has a successful career as an executive vice president of a Chicago public relations firm. This year, she created a scholarship to honor the memory of her late mother.

After graduation, Lloyd, who was named the Distinguished Alumnus, went on to develop a highly successful career in the national and international music industry, a passion he has held near to his heart since he was a child. He credits Moraine Valley faculty with cultivating that passion and teaching him invaluable lessons. Lloyd has continued to give back by returning to the college to inspire students considering the same career path.

Navejas transformed his life after coming to the United States and obtaining an education that began at Moraine Valley. He is a highly praised author whose book on immigration is used in colleges and universities across the country. He continues to visit schools, bookstores and libraries to encourage students and residents to continue their education.

He went on to become an award-winning real estate broker and has supported the Muslim and Arab student scholarships at Moraine Valley to help future students achieve their educational goals.

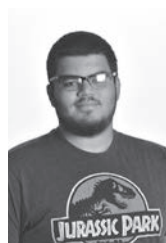

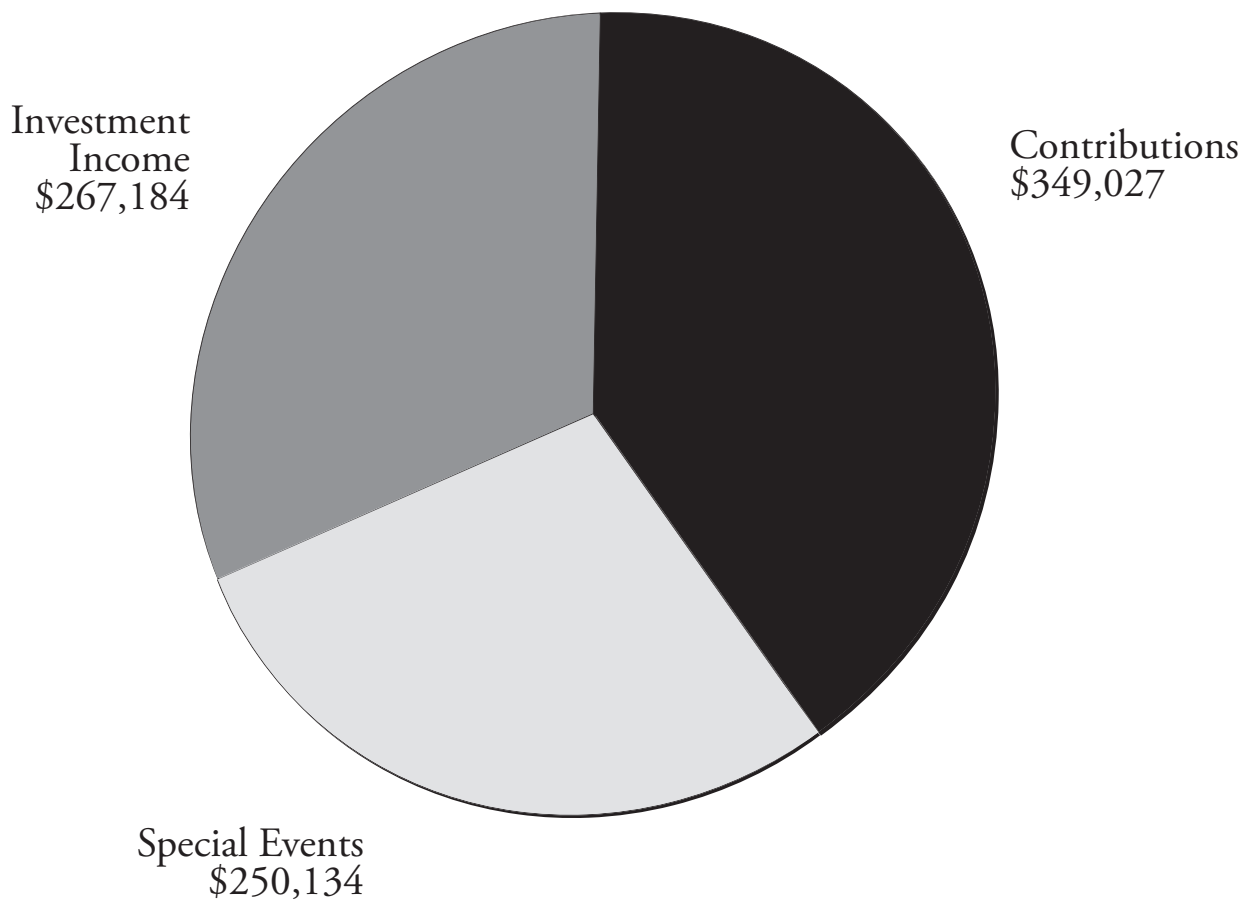

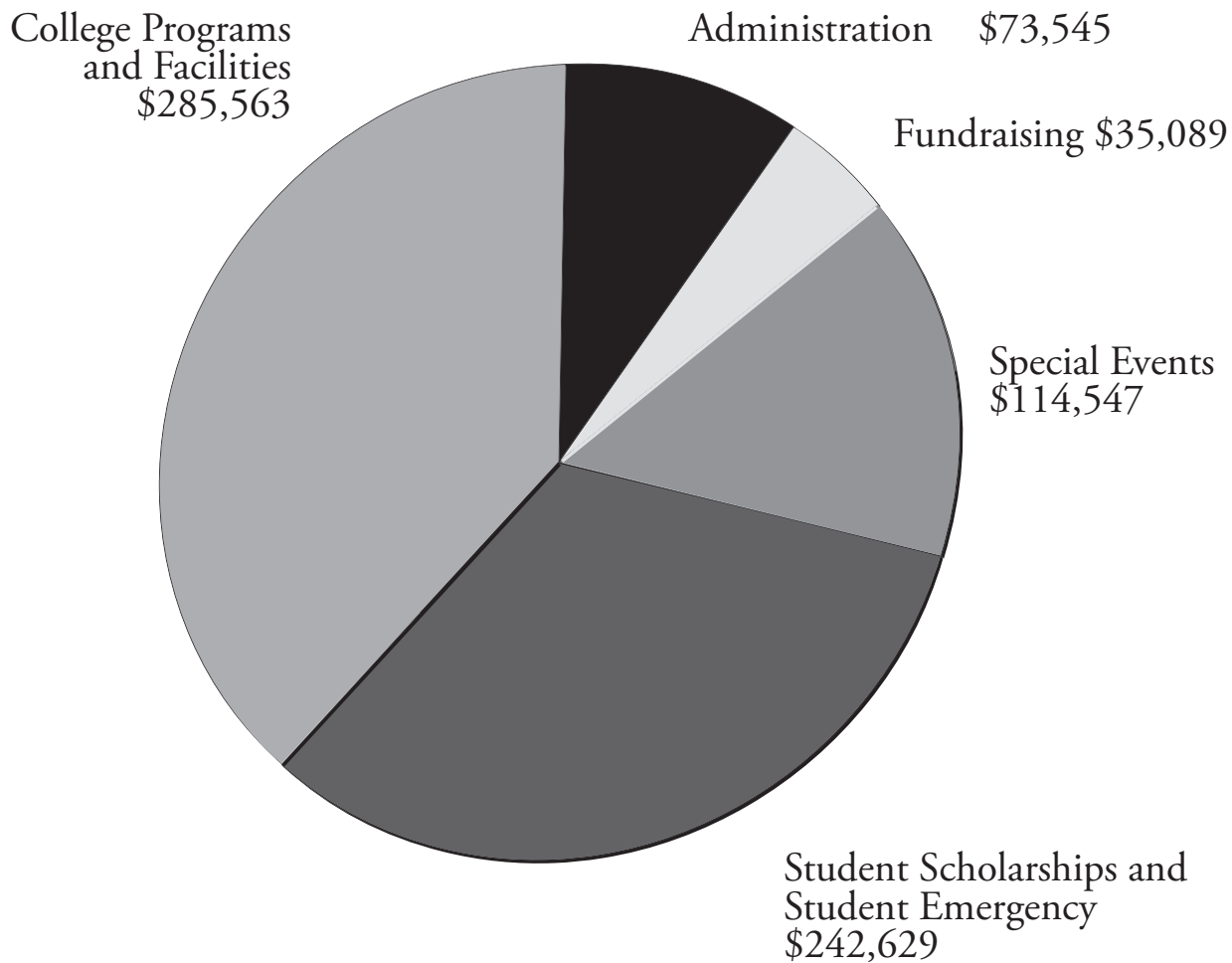

and Program Expenses**

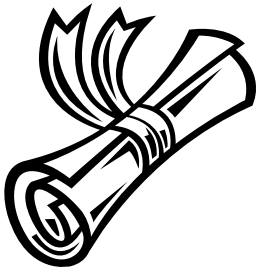

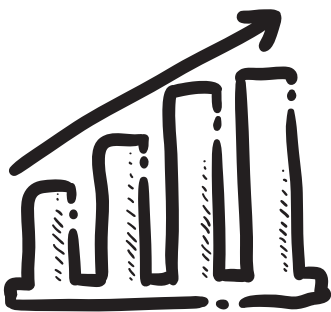

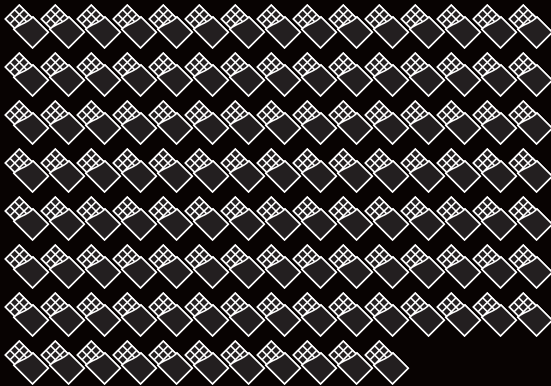
