☐	☐	English requirement is met by one of the following: • Test into college level for English and Reading determined by Moraine Valley placement test. Placement tests, ACT and SAT scores expire 18 months from test date. • ACT score in English and Reading of 19 or higher OR SAT score of 480 or higher • Completion of all developmental levels in both English and Reading at Moraine Valley • Previous college-level English composition credit with a grade of "C" or higher.
☐	☐	One year of high school biology with lab, or one semester of college biology with lab, with a grade of "C" or better. One year of high school algebra must qualify to take Moraine Valley course MTH-109 or above, or a college-level course at another college, with a grade of "D" or above.
☐	☐	A minimum grade point average of 2.0 based on a four-point system. The high school GPA will be used only if students have attempted less than 12 college hours. A GPA of 2.5 will be assigned if the student took the high school equivalency rather than graduate from high school.

The applicant must submit the following:

- Official sealed high school or high school equivalency transcripts – current transcript must show either the graduation date or the ongoing student status.
- Official sealed college transcripts (if applicable).
- A copy of Illinois state-issued ID. Qualified residents of the district and residents of districts engaged in cooperative agreements are given priority over out-of-district students for program admission.
