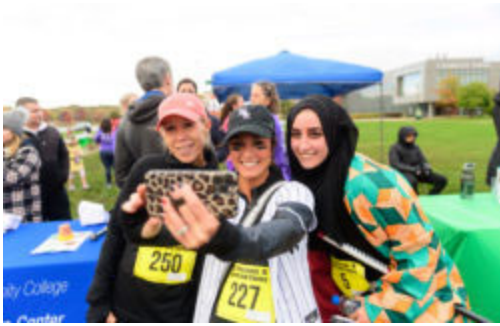

All proceeds from the event go toward funding scholarships for Moraine Valley students.

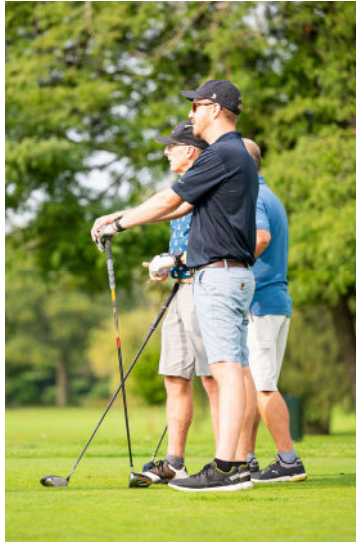

High School Health Care Career Fair

Moraine Valley Community College is hosting a Health Care Career Fair for high school students on Friday, Oct. 13, 9 to 11:15 a.m., in Building B, Room B119 on campus, 9000 W. College Parkway, Palos Hills.

Students will learn about careers in the health care field and related programs at Moraine Valley, including Nursing, Basic Nurse Assistant, Radiologic Technology, Phlebotomy, Patient Care Technicians, Therapeutic Massage, Respiratory Therapy, Sleep Technology, Medical Assistants and Addictions Studies.

At the fair, Northwestern Medicine and Palos Hospital will present sessions, and tables with information on the different programs will line the halls of Building B.

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Moraine Valley hosting Fire Science/First Responder Open House

Moraine Valley Community College is hosting a [Fire Science/First Responder](#) Career Day for high school

students on Monday, Oct. 2, 9:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m., in Building T on campus, 9000 W. College Parkway, Palos Hills.

Students will learn about this career through hands-on teaching and learning stations, including a forcible entry simulator, trying on firefighting gear, a thermal imager presentation, and fire hose handling and fire extinguisher training. They also will hear about firefighting and EMT classes and observe a side-by-side burn in sprinkler rooms, demonstrating the importance of smoke detectors and sprinkler systems.
